# 1. Vinay Sahasrabuddhe becomes ICCR Chief.

- Vinay Sahasrabuddhe, also a member of Rajya Sabha, has been appointed the President of Indian Council of Cultural Relations.
- He will replace Lokesh Chandra who was appointed in Oct 2014.
   2.Arunachal Pradesh declared open defecation free.
- The milestone was achieved after the state announced an incentive of Rs.8,000 in addition to the Rs. 12,000 grant provided by the Centre for building toilets.
- Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Haryana and Madhya Pradesh were declared open defecation free in Oct 2017.
  - 3.1.9 cr legal citizens recognized in first NRC draft in Assam.
- The first draft of the National Register of Citizens(NRC) for Assam recognized 1.9 erore people as Indian citizens. The verification process for the rest 1.39 crore applicants is still on
- Assam, which has witnessed an influx of migrants from Bangladesh, became the only state to have NRC in
  - 4. Muslim women freed from Triple Talaq: PM Modi.
- PM Modi said that Muslim women have found a way to free themselves from the practice of Triple Talaq after years of struggle.
- PM Modi also hailed the Centre's decision to remove the practice that banned Muslim women from
  performing Haj without the company of a male guardian.
  International News
  - 1.N Korea could visit S Korea for Winter Olympics.
- Kim Jong-un said that the nation could send a delegation to S Korea to take part in the 2018 Winter Olympics. Winter Games will take place from Feb 9 to 25.
- He added that the Olympies will "serve as a good chance to display our Korean people's grace toward the world and we sincerely hope the games will be a success".
  2.Solo climbing on Mount Everest banned by Nepal.
- This law has been revised to make mountaineering safer and to decrease deaths.
- Avtar Singh Cheema was the first Indian to climb Mount Everest successfully. **3.Israel withdraws from UNESCO.**
- Israel has filed notice to withdraw from the UNESCO alongside the United States. Both Israel and US have filed its own withdrawal notice in Oct 2017.
- Israel was the member of UNESCO since 1949.
  4.US Vice President trolled with "Make America Gay Again" flag.



- US Vice President Mike Pence was trolled with a rainbow flag stating "Make America Gay Again" by his neighbors.
- The Vice President is opposed to same-sex marriage and had previously opposed a law prohibiting discrimination against LGBT people in the workplace.

1.GST e-way bill system to be implemented from Feb 1.

- The GST provision requiring transporters to carry an electronic waybill or e-way bill when moving goods between states will be implemented from Feb 1.
- This is done to check rampant tax evasion and boost revenues by up to 20%.
  2.Maruti reported 10.3% increase in total sales.
- The country's largest car-maker Maruti Suzuki India(MSI) reported 10.3% there are in total sales at 1,30,066 units in Dec 2017 compared to 1,17,908 units in the same month of 2016.
- The company's domestic sales stood at 1,19,286 units, up 12.1% from 1,06,414 units in Dec 2016. **3.Bandhan Bank to offer 11.9 crore shares in IPO.**
- Bandhan Bank has filed the Draft Red Herring Prospectus with SEBI for an Initial Public Offer(IPO) next fiscal offering 11.9 crore equity shares.
- The bank proposes to offer up to 119,280,494 equity shares of face value of Rs.10 each at a price to be
  determined through a book building process including premium.

  - 1. Shiv Kapur won third Asian Tour title of 2017
- Indian golfer Shiv Kapur won his third Asian Tour title of 2017 by lifting the Royal Cup in Thailand.
- Kapur first won on Asian Tour in his debut season in December 2005.
   2.Ponting to coach Australia for T20 WC.
- The Cricket Australia is negotiating with Ricky Ponting who earlier had served as an assistant coach for T20I team in 2017.
- Ponting, meanwhile, will also assist Lehmann for T20I series against England and New Zealand.

  3.Manchester City's record 18-game win streak ends with 0-0 draw.
- Manche le City's record-setting 18-match win streak came to an end with an 0-0 draw against Crystal Palace.
- City were two wins away from breaking Bayern Munich's record of 19 consecutive top-flight wins in Europe's top five leagues.

- 1. Kolkata to get its first floating market
- 'The Floating Market of Patuli' is likely to be open for public in January.



- The market will house over 200 shops.
  - 2. 2.9 lakh doctors go on a strike against NMC Bill
- The doctors from across the country's private hospitals are opposing the National Medical Commission Bill.
- Doctors claim the bill, seeking to replace the Medical Council of India with a new body is anti-poor.
   India ranks third in world in nanotechnology: Harsh Vardhan
- Union Minister of Science Harsh Vardhan was addressing an event commemorating scientist SN Bose's 125th birth anniversary.
- He said that India is fifth in terms of scientific publications.
  - 4. Delhi Police to learn foreign languages
- They are planning to provide better assistance to foreign nationals by learning Russian, German, Spanish, Portuguese, Japanese and French besides English.
- They are taught basic words and sentences of foreign languages.
   International News
  - 1. UN Chief issues global 'red alert'
- In his New Year's message, Antonio Guterres has pointed out that 2017 was marked by conflicts and new dangers.
- He further urged the world leaders to bridge the divides and rebuild trust by bringing people together.
   2. California legalises sale of marijuana
- The US State of California has legalised the sale of recreational marijuana 20 years after legalising its medical use.
- It has become the 6th US state to do so, however, the cannabis remains classified as an illegal narcotic under the US law.
  - 3. US mulls H-1B visa changes
- The US administration is considering a proposal to end the provision of granting extensions to H-1B
   visa holders whose applications for Green Card had been pending.
- 7.5 lakh Indian HAB visa holders could be deported from the US if the proposal gets implemented.

  - 1. Saudi Arabia, UAE introduce VAT
- This comes as the Gulf nations aim to diversify their revenue generation from sources other than oil and cope with low oil prices.
- Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman and Qatar have also committed to introducing VAT.
  - 2. E-commerce sites must show MRP



- The Centre has made it mandatory for the firms to display the maximum retail price on goods from today.
- The companies have to display manufacturing and expiry date, net quantity, country of origin and consumer care details on the label.
  - 3. Foreign bank ATMs in India fell 18%
- The number has fell from 1141 to 934 over the last 3 years.
- The reason for the reduction is mainly due to the banks closing their retail operations in India Sports News
  - 1. S Korea offers talks with N Korea on Olympics participation
- The talks are with respect to the 2018 Winter Olympic Games in South Korea
- This comes after Kim Jong-un said that the nation could send a delegation to S Korea to take part in the games.
  - 2. Manchester United beat Everton
- Manchester United defeated Everton 2-0 to register their first victory after 3 successive draws in the Premier League.
- United moved to the 2nd place and are 12 points behind the city rivals Manchester City.

- 1.GAIL commissions India's second largest rooftop solar plant in UP.
- State-owned utility GAIL India Ltd has installed a 5.76MWp(Mega Watt peak) solar plant at its petrochemical complex at Pata in Uttar Pradesh.
- Tata Power Solar commissioned a 12MW solar rooftop project in Amritsar, Punjab which is India's largest rooftop solar plant.
  - 2. Open defecation will have Rs. 500 fine in Maharashtra.
- According to the rules framed by the state govt of Maharashtra, a spot fine of Rs.500 will be imposed on people found defecating in open.
- While a fine of Rs.180 will be imposed for littering and Rs100-150 will be imposed for spitting in public.
  - 3.FIR filed against Mewani over provocative speech before Maha riots.
- Police complaint has been filed against Gujarat MLA Jignesh Mewani and JNU student Umar Khalid for allegedly making inflammatory speeches in Maharashtra a day before the Bhima-Koregaon violence broke out.
- A 28-year-old man was killed in the violence sparked in Pune.
   4.No plan to make all vehicles In India electric by 2030: Govt.



- There are no plans to make all vehicles electricity-powered by 2030, said Minister of State for Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises Babul Supriyo.
- Earlier, Minister of State for Renewable Energy Piyush Goyal stated no petrol or diesel cars should be sold by 2030.

- 1.6 nations join UNSC as non-permanent members.
- Equatorial Guinea, Ivory Coast, Kuwait, the Netherlands, Peru and Poland formally joined the United Nations Security Council as non-permanent members while Egypt, Italy, Japan, Senegal, Ukraine and Uruguay left the council last week.
- The UNSC has 15 members, of which five members are permanent while ten non-permanent members are elected for two-year terms by the General Assembly.
   2.Turkey's endangered 'Bird language' entered in UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage list.
- UNESCO has accepted the "bird language" of Black Sea villagers as an endangered part of world heritage in need of urgent protection.
- This "bird language" is unusual and very efficient whistle language used as a means of communication by villagers in remote northern Turkey
   3.Iran re-opened two border crossings with Iraq's Kurdistan.
- Iran closed the border posts in last year in response to the region's independence vote which was deemed illegal by the Iraqi government.
- Over 92% Iraqi Kurds had voted in favour of independence from Iraq in the referendum. Kurds are
  the fourth-largest ethnic group in Middle-East.
  - 4. Yuan for Bilateral trade and Investment activities allowed by Pakistan.
- According to Pakistan external affairs ministry, both public and private sector enterprises of Pakistan
  and China are free to choose Yuan for bilateral trade and investment activities.
- Yuan is an approved foreign currency for denominating foreign currency transactions in Pakistan, as per current foreign exchange regulations.

- 1.SBI, NABARD tie up to promote Joint Liability Groups in Bengal.
- SBI and NABARD have signed an agreement with 5 NGOs in Bengal for the promotion of 2,500 joint liability groups(JLGs) in select districts of State.
- JLGs are informal groups of 4-10 members engaged in similar economic activities and willing to
  jointly undertake the responsibility to repay loans taken by the group from a bank.
   2.HDFC Bank partners with Rajasthan Govt. to promote startup culture.



- HDFC bank, India's largest private bank by market capitalisation, has announced a partnership with Rajasthan govt to promote and nurture startups in the state.
- RBI has labelled HDFC bank as 'domestic systematically important bank' i.e. too big to fail.
   3.India's GDP growth will accelerate to 7.6% in FY20: HSBC.
- HSBC, headquarters at London, reported that India's growth rate is expected to accelerate at around 6.5% in 2017-18 and is likely to improve further to 7.6% by 2019-20.
- The result is expected as key sectors would revive from disruptions related to the implementations of GST and Demonetisation.
  - 4.RBI bond schemes being replaced by Saving bonds scheme.
- RBI bonds has not been closed but the interest rates on such papers have been lowered to 7.75%, according to the finance ministry.
- The 8% Saving bond scheme, also known as RBI bond scheme, is not being closed but is being replaced by 7.75% Saving Bond Scheme.

- 1.G Sathiyan became Highest Ranked player in ITTF for India.
- G Sathiyan has become India's highest-ranked player in the latest International Table Tennis Federation rankings.
- The current ranking of Sathiyan is 49. He surpassed his compatriot Sharath Kamal who has 51st rank.
  - 2.Colin Munro became the 1st batsman to hit 3 T20I hundreds.
- New Zealand opener Colin Munro became the first cricketer to hit 3 centuries in T20I cricket after smashing a 47-ball ton against West Indies.
- Munro scored 104 runs off 53 balls to help New Zealand post their highest-ever T20l total of 243/5.
   National News
  - 1. Karnataka CM gives free laptops to SC/ST students
- Karnataka CM Siddaramaiah provided free laptops worth Rs.45 cr ahead of the state Assembly polls scheduled this year.
- 1.5 lakh laptops will be distributed to SC/ST students under a scheme rolled out in 2016-17.
  - 2. Centre declares Hyderabad as open defecation free
- Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation undertook measures such as the construction of 98 public toilets.
- The GHMC Commissioner said they will take measures to retain the ODF tag.
   AlADMK to launch new TV Channel, Newspaper
- The newspaper will be named as Nam Amma while the channel will be named as Amma TV.



- Namadhu MGR daily and Jaya TV Network are now controlled by jailed leader VK Sasikala and her family.
  - 4. Over 300 detained, 16 FIRs filed in Mumbai during Maha Bandh
- Incidents of road and rail route blockades were reported during the bandh.
- BR Ambedkar's grandson had called for the bandh over the clashes that erupted on Bhima Koregaon battle's 200th anniversary.

- 1. Jadhav thanks Pakistan, blames India
- Pakistan has released a video in which ex-Indian Navy officer Kulbhushan Jadhav is thanking
   Pakistan for allowing him to meet his mother and wife last week.
- He also said he felt his mother and wife were scared during the meeting as an Indian diplomat was shouting at them.
  - 2. Power prices go negative in Germany due to overproduction
- Consumers were paid to consume electricity as power grids were loaded due to overproduction.
- This is a frequent occurrence in the country as electricity produced from sources like Sun and wind.
  - 3. Pakistan test-fires indigenously-built naval cruise missile
- 'Harba' is capable of hitting the target from surface to surface and ground assault.
- The missile was launched from PNS Himmat which is fitted with state-of-the-art sensors and weapons.

- 1. Salil Parekh to get Rs.16.25 cr as salary
- Infosys CEO will receive a salary of Rs.16.25 cr which includes a variable pay of Rs.9.75 cr.
- His predecessor Vishal Sikka's total remuneration in 2016-17 was about Rs.45 cr.
  - 2. 'New' RCom to be India's largest B2B business : Anil Ambani
- The company had recently announced its exit from mobile business and signed an agreement with Jio to sell off its wireless assets.
- Ambani added that RCom will have a strategic partner in the next few months.
  - 3. SRL\_becomes 1st Indian diagnostic firm to hit Rs.1k cr revenue
- SRL Diagnostics treats over 15 million patients annually in 600 cities across India.
- The firm is also the lab partner for UNICEF's Comprehensive National Nutrition Survey.

- 2 time IPL champions Chennai Super Kings are returning to the tournament after 2 years.
- Mumbai Indians retained Rohit Sharma.
  - 2. SC directs BCCI to allow Bihar to take part in Ranji Trophy



- Bihar, who last played Ranji Trophy in 2003-04 were omitted after Jharkhand won the right to play in India's premier domestic tournament.
- The SC order comes in the wake of plea by Cricket Association of Bihar.

- 1.Meghalaya signed host city contract for 39th National Games.
- Meghalaya signed the Host City Contract with the Indian Olympic Association(IOA) for hosting the 39th National Games in 2022.
- Meghalaya had made the bid to host the 39th National Games after successfully co-hosting the South Asian Games in 2017.
  - 2.Goa will host 3rd edition of Science Film Festival.
- This festival, titled SCI-FFI Goa, is being organized by the state-based Vidnyan Parishad, Goa
   Department of Science and Technology.
- The competition aims to boost the culture of science films, all the films submitted should be related to science and technology.
  - 3. 'Swachh Sarvekshan Survey 2018' launched in India.
- The world's biggest 'Swachh Sarvekshan 2018' was launched in India by PM Modi. It will be conducted from the 4th January to 10th March.
- Under the first survey, Swachh Sarvekshan 2016, Mysuru had topped the list while in Swachh Sarvekshan 2017, Indore emerged as the cleanest city.
  - 4. Union budget will be presented on Feb 1.
- The cabinet committee said that the budget session of Parliament will commence from Jan 29 and the Union Budget 2018 will be presented on Feb 1.
- This will be the last full budget before polls.

- 1.Pakistan excluded from the SAARC initiative.
- India has excluded Pakistan from the list of SAARC member countries with which it will be connecting its state-of-the-art National Knowledge Network(NKN) for sharing scientific databases and remote access to advanced research facilities.
- The SAARC Secretariat is based in Kathmandu, Nepal.
  2.No evidence that Saudi was involved in 9/11 attack.
- Saudi Arabia said that there is no evidence to support the US lawsuit alleging that the Kingdom was involved in the 9/11 terror attack in the US.
- As many as 15 of the 19 terrorists involved in the 2001 attack were Saudi citizens.
   3.Security aid to Pak cut by US.



- The US has suspended around 900 million dollars in security assistance to Pakistan for failing to take action against terrorist groups Afghan Taliban and Haqqani Network.
- The US recently cut a 255 million dollars military aid to Pakistan over its terrorist safe havens.
   4.Saudi Arabia arrests over 3 lakh foreigners living illegally.
- Saudi Arabia has arrested over 3.3 lakh foreigners, most of them without residence or work permits, in a nationwide crackdown against violators of the Kingdom's residency and labour regulations.
- Almost 32 lakh Indians live in Saudi Arabia. Indians form the Kingdom's largest expatriate community.

- 1. After finding a security flaw in chips, Intel shares fall by 2%.
- The fall was after the researchers found a security flaw in the company's chips, that could affect computers and the phones globally.
- Intel admitted the flaw and said that exploits do not have the potential to delete the data.
   2.Govt seeks approval for bank infusion plan.
- The govt has sought Parliament's approval to issue bonds worth Rs.80,000 crore to fund capital infusion into public-sector banks.
- The govt is expected to issue recapitalization bonds worth Rs.1.35 trillion under the plan.
   3.Ripple co-founder richer than Google Founders.
- As Ripple rose to as much 3.84 dollars, Bitcoin's rival Ripple's co-founder Chris Larsen, with networth of 59.8 billion dollars on paper is now richer than Google founders Larry Page and Sergey Brin.
- Ripple became the world's second largest cryptocurrency surpassing Ethereum.

  4.Ethereum crosses \$1000 for the first time ever.
- Ethereum surpassed the 1000 dollar milestone for the first time to reach a record high of \$1045.
- Ethereum is the third largest cryptocurrency and now has a market capitalization of over \$100 billion.

  - 1. Mohamed Salah named as African footballer of 2017.
- Liverpool's Egyptian forward Mohamed Salah was named as the African footballer of the year 2017.
- Salah got 625 points from the voting panel, helped Egypt reach the African Nations Cup final and qualify for this year's World Cup.
  - 2. Serena William withdraws from Australian Open.
- Serena Williams, 23 times Grand slam champion, has withdrawn from the Australian Open 2018 edition of the tournament.



 She withdrew claiming that her preparations had fallen short and said that she just doesn't want to compete.

- 1. Kerala police to wear body cams to improve security
- The cameras will be a part of the uniform and have features such as live streaming, infrared facilities and 8 hrs of battery backup.
- This would also help to record behaviour and conduct of police officers.
  - 2. Lalu sentenced to 3.5 yrs in Jail
- Rashtriya Janata Dal chief Lalu Prasad Yadav was sentenced to three and a half years in prison and fined Rs 5 lakh in the Rs.89 lakh fodder scam case.
- The scam was exposed in 1996, leading to Yadav's resignation as the Bihar CM
  - 3. Mamata Banerjee unveils official emblem of West Bengal govt
- The emblem featuring the 'Biswa Bangla' logo has been designed by the chief minister herself.
- She said that a proposal seeking to change the name of the state has also been sent to the Centre.
  - 4. Maharashtra to form its own international school board
- The Maharashtra International Education Board will be an autonomous body which will design curriculum for schools and conduct examinations.
- The board will help students who can't afford an international-level education at private schools. *International News* 
  - 1. China may deploy naval destroyer in Indian Ocean
- The 10,000 tonne naval destroyer is equipped with anti-missile and anti-submarine weapons.
- This comes after reports suggested that China has built an underwater surveillance network in the Indian Ocean.
  - 2. ISIS declares war on terrorist organisation Hamas
- ISIS declared a war on Flamas for failing to stop US' decision to recognise Jerusalem as Israel's capital.
- The Egyptian wing of SIS also accused Hamas of fighting its supporters in Gaza and called on its followers to carry out attacks against the militant group.
  - 3. Handshake ban in churches in Northern Ireland
- A Catholic diocese in Northern Ireland has banned handshake in its masses due to the risk of infection from the flu that has spread across the UK and Ireland.
- The flu was first discovered in Australia and has claimed 72 lives.

  - 1. GDP growth to be more robust in next fiscal: NITI Aayog



- NITI Aayog VC Rajiv Kumar said that India's economic activity has been picking up for the last three quarters.
- The Indian economy grew at 7.1% in 2016-17.
  - 2. TRON surges 13,800% in one month
- TRON has become the world's sixth largest cryptocurrency.
- The market capitalisation of TRON has increased from 139mnto139mnto19.7 bn in the last one month
  - 3. SBI may cut minimum balance limit in savings accounts
- SBI is planning to bring down the limit from Rs.3000 to Rs.1000.
- This comes after a Finance Ministry report that showed SBI collected Rs 1771 or as charges from customers who didn't maintain the minimum balance.

  - 1. Simona Halep wins Shenzen Open
- Simona Halep beat defending champion Katerina Siniakova in the final of the Shenzhen Open.
- Halep broke her opponent three times in the final set to seal the win.
  - 2. Hockey Indian names players for junior men's national camp
- Hockey India named 33 members for junior men's national camp, to be held from January 7 to March 15.
- The camp will be held in Bengaluru.

- 1. Railways to equip country's all 8,500 stations with Wi-Fi
- It is expected to be complete by March 2019 at an estimated cost of Rs.700 cr.
- Presently, 216 railway stations are offering Wi-Fi under the Digital India initiative.
  - 2. Over 900 flights to be cancelled before Jan 26th
- Delhi International Airport Limited has asked airlines to cancel all domestic flights scheduled from Jan 18 to Jan 26.
- This may lead to cancellation of more than 100 domestic flights each day for Republic Day parade rehearsals.
  - 3. Haj House in UP repainted
- The outer walls of the Haj House in UP which were painted saffron by the govt have been repainted white.
- Painting the walls saffron had triggered opposition from various political parties and seminary Darul Uloom.

  - 2. Iran declares victory over anti-govt protests
- The IRGC blamed countries including the US, Israel and Saudi Arabia for the unrest.
- More than 1,000 were arrested during the protests that began in December.
  - 3. China's space lab could fall to Earth by March
- Tiangong-1 had been declared "out of control" by China in 2016.
- Most of the 8.5 tonne station is expected to burn during re-entry to Earth, but humans can come in contact with the remnants of toxic rocket fuel.

- 1. Haryana to launch High Risk Pregnancy Portal.
- Haryana has become the first state to launch High Risk Pregnancy(HRP) Portal.
- This web application has been designed to track every high risk pregnant woman till 42 days after delivery so that she receives adequate treatment.

2.Indian Navy and Cochin Port Trust(CPT) signed MoU.



- The Indian Navy has inked an MoU with Cochin Port Trust(CPT), Kerala towards leasing of 228
  meters of berths at Mattancherry Wharf for a period of 5 years.
- This is the first time such an agreement has been signed between Indian Navy and CPT.
   3.FTII to be set up in Arunachal Pradesh.
- Jitendra Singh, Minister of State(I/C) of the ministry of Development of North-Eastern region, announced that Arunachal Pradesh will get Film and Television Institute of India(FTII).
- The first FTII was set up in Pune in 1960 having current Chairman as Anupam Khen
   4.Rs.32,000 cr Make in India Warship project cancelled by Govt.
- The project was aimed at constructing 12 advanced minesweeper warships in collaboration with South Korea at the Goa shipyard.
- The warships destroy underwater mines laid by enemy forces. Only four minesweeper are presently operating.

- 1.Dormant volcano located in Papua New Guinea erupts for the first time.
